

How it works – the cogs icon, integrates with EDI


In the cloud

Routing code- distinguish between own truck, carrier, customer pickup plus other options


Routing code displays in OE01





Dispatch is about making arrangement for freight, from Pickup to delivery.

The TMS system tracks all these statuses – clients can also see them on Mylogistics, as well as receive 214 shipment status messages



A big part of a dispatchers job is keeping track of appointments – this is not the warehouse appointment system per se, but appointments for the truck or carrier you are using.

Generally includes pickup and delivery appointment times. A quick pop screen gives the dispatcher the ability to do this


BILLING

- Standard LTL Rates
- Accessorial charges; e.g., liftgate, notification, residential charges





BILLING





- For spot quotes
- Replaces RA50 Quote Entry (works like BL01)
- Print/email quote on eDocs form
- Convert quote to probill in BL01
- · Highview for quotes







This will expand greatly the old quote feature

The current RA50 would be replaced with a program very similar to BL01 so that the same fields can be used including the ship from and ship to codes, weight, pieces, freight class. This would result in the quote number being created


The new RA50 will work like BL01 and the user can either use the standard rate tables RA19 / RA30 or enter in most cases use a miscellaneous charge code from FM19

When recalling the quote in BL01 the system would update the fields from the quote e.g. ship to and ship from codes, weight, pieces etc.

Document print function which would print the details of the rate quote in a graphical document suitable for emailing out as a pdf

Quote form legal text can be either for Air/Ocean or LTL – the form will print the appropriate legal text depending on the Freight type

Document print function for a quote summary that shows revenue and cost New Highview for rate quotes that would show both the quote and the corresponding probill that resulted – this would allow for analysis and comparison between quotes and what actually occurred using statuses like: open, closed or cancelled.


now can be avoided by importing from a spreadsheet - RA60 - for both billable and payable

If you have several carriers and they send you their rates, with minor adjustments to the sheet you should be able to import them
